### **New Marina Offers Hi Tech Satellite Television**

Receiving Satellite Television, when docked, just got a whole lot easier. The new, high-tech installation at Pier 32 Marina, just south of San Diego, designed by Commercial Satellite of San Diego, is now operational.

Pier 32 Marina offers HD Satellite Television at each of their 250 boat slips in National City, California. One coaxial cable attached to a dock box will supply up to 250 channels of programming (with an attached satellite-receiver), over 100 channels are in high definition for new flat screen TVs. Larger vessels can operate up to 8 satellite-receivers with just the one cable connected.

San Diego based Commercial Satellite designed and installed the satellite Television distribution system. It is a new and innovative technological system in the world of docked watercraft. Two, land-based, small, and hidden satellite antennas receive all the signals. Jonathan Feld, President of Commercial Satellite, says "The Marina Developer contacted us in their design stage. They wanted an aesthetically pleasing system, without satellite dishes attached to decks, pilings or the dock mooring supports."

Each boat slip tenant signs up and pays for their individual programming at residential rates. “What makes this system unique,” said Feld “is that all of the satellite companies 100+ high definition channels are available including a package which will provide all of the professional football games, and you don’t see a dish.”

The unique distribution system was initially designed for large office buildings and airport concourses where multiple independent subscribers could utilize a small, single satellite antenna and receive high definition programming.

Commercial Satellite intends to roll out their unique digital satellite distribution system to marinas in California, and eventually nationwide. This includes inland lake marinas throughout the US. December 2008 sees the activation of their latest project at San Diego’s newest marina called, “The Wharf”.
